**RESOLUTION RECEIVING FEASIBILITY REPORT AND CALLING HEARING ON
IMPROVEMENT FOR THE 2022 STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT CP 22-1**

WHEREAS, a report has been prepared by SEH, Inc. with reference to the improvement by street reconstruction, including aggregate base and bituminous surfacing, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 429.011 to 429.111; and

WHEREAS, Crusader Avenue between Bidwell Street and Robert Street and the Humboldt Avenue cul-de-sac are the roadways in the report; and

WHEREAS, the report provides information regarding whether the proposed project is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the West St. Paul City Council that:

1. The Council will consider the improvement to the before mentioned street in accordance with the report and the assessment of abutting property for all or a portion of the cost of the improvement pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429 at an estimated total cost of the improvement of \$1,631,523.
2. A Public Hearing shall be held on such proposed improvement on June 14, 2021 in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Center at 6:30 p.m. and the City Clerk shall give mailed and published notice of such hearing and improvement as required by law.
