Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee CIP Recommendations

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Over the past 18 months the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee (PRAC) has been working on an inventory of each City park. Each month the committee chose 1-2 parks to visit and discuss. Using the 2000 Parks Master Plan as a guide, members talked through needed improvements and added amenities for each park. The final list was reviewed at the April 13, 2021 PRAC Work Session and is being presented to Council as the PRAC recommendations for future Park CIP improvements. Staff has added some dates for known improvements as well as possible years and amounts for other projects. If approved by Council staff will use the recommendations to help guide future park planning and CIP budgeting.

FISCAL IMPACT:

All recommendations will go through the CIP process.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Discuss the recommendations from the PRAC for future park improvements.
