Theft and fraud through the use of stolen credit cards is nothing new but over the past couple of years we have seen a rise in this type of crime that takes considerable resources to investigate, charge and prosecute. Shakopee passed an ordinance similar to what is being proposed for West St Paul. Last year they had only two cases of fraud involving the purchasing of gift cards with stolen credit or debit cards. Shakopee's work in passing this ordinance earned them an innovation award from the League of Minnesota Cities.

There are two distinct differences in this proposed ordinance than the ordinance Shakopee passed. First, this ordinance covers all third party gift cards. Secondly, we are not making this a criminal violation, but a civil penalty through the administration citation process directed at the business for violations. We will continue to work with merchants through this process and educate them further on the ordinance.
